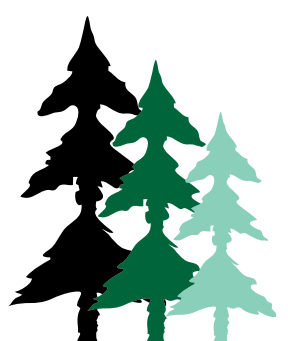

BROUGHAM CASTLE: Located just a couple of miles from A.W. Jenkinson's Clifton headquarters at the River Eamont crossing on the eastern flank of Penrith, Brougham Castle was built in the early 13th century. Both a formidable barrier against invaders and a prestigious residence, the castle welcomed 'Hammer of the Scots' Edward I in 1300. A complex of passages and spiral stairways makes Brougham a fascinating castle to explore, as well as an ideal picnic setting for a family day out.

LOCKERBIE: A.W. Jenkinson's Steven's Croft site, just off the M74 at Lockerbie, is adjacent to E.ON's 44 Megawatt CO₂-neutral biomass power station. A.W. Jenkinson has built a close working partnership with E.ON and is responsible for supplying all fuel to the site. Steven's Croft plays an integral part in A.W. Jenkinson's Scottish operations, receiving material from most of the sawmills in Scotland, as well as supplying other major biomass and panelboard customers.

MARCH 2013

ARABLE FARMING: Jenkinson's arable farming activities benefit extensively from the latest integrated GPS-referenced IT. Variations in soil nutrient balance are highlighted through targeted analysis by the Farm's agronomist. Evidence of disease or lack of nutrients is pinpointed within a specific area of a field and targeted directly with cutting-edge computer-controlled variable rate spreading technology. Applied in conjunction with manure from the Farm's over-wintering stock, this close control of localised fertility helps ensure maximised production, whilst minimising use of agrochemicals and artificial fertilisers; cutting the risk of potentially damaging run-off to local water courses.

FORESTRY SERVICES: Eskdalemuir Forest in the Scottish Borders is one of the largest privately-owned plantation forests in the UK: A wide range of individual ownerships all managing their investments on a long-term sustainable basis providing timber for industry, habitats for wildlife and conservation and long-term employment for the local and regional community. Timber from Eskdalemuir travels out to a range of customers via the purpose-built timber haulage route, thereby removing heavy traffic from Eskdalemuir village and the rural public roads.

Jenkinson maintain a breeding herd of 150 home-bred pedigree Limousin females. The Farm's cows are serviced by some of the nation's finest bulls, including Dolcorsllwyn Fabio, bought for the world record price of 120,000 guineas. Their semen and progeny are sold at society auctions and go on to improve other herds across the UK.

THE WHOLE TREE: A.W. Jenkinson can make use of any part of any tree, hardwood or softwood, any species, roundwood or brash. Green material can be composted, roundwood chipped or processed into shavings and stump material, branches and brash used as biomass fuel. Slabwood, offcuts and trimmings are used in the manufacture of panel board and bark has uses in the amenity and horticultural sectors. Here, forest brash is being chipped, ready for use as fuel in a biomass power plant.

AUGUST 2013

HARVEST: After nearly a year of care and nurture, crops which were sown in the previous autumn are ready for harvest. From a total of 1,800 acres farmed by Messrs. Jenkinson, 800 acres are sown in a rotation of winter wheat, oilseed rape, spring oats, and winter and spring barley. As a result the Farm is almost self-sufficient in feed production, with a surplus of wheat, barley and oilseed rape being sold on the open market.

RURAL SERVICE: A.W. Jenkinson Forest Products was formed in the mid-1960s when founder, Allan Jenkinson, started collecting unwanted sawdust from the Cumbrian mills. He transported it to local farms, where sawdust is in great demand as cattle bedding. Today, A.W. Jenkinson still operates a dedicated fleet of small vehicles, trailer combination units and four axle vehicles that are capable of making bulk deliveries of loose and baled shavings and sawdust to even the most inaccessible of sites.
